<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Praise, reward, and encourage the children</li> <li>2. Use paddling as an alternate form of suspension</li> <li>3. Model appropriate behavior for children</li> <li>4. Modify the classroom environment</li> <li>5. Nurture/Listen to children</li> <li>6. Provide alternatives for bad behavior</li> <li>7. Provide the children with natural consequences for behavior.</li> <li>8. Treat the children as people and respect their needs, desires, and feelings</li> <li>9. Ignore minor misbehaviors</li> <li>10. Explain things to children on their level</li> <li>11. Use short supervised periods of "time-out"</li> <li>12. Stay consistent in our behavior management program</li> <li>13. Offer child and family counseling services</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Shake, bite, pinch, push, pull, or slap</li> <li>2. Make fun of, yell, threaten, use profanity, or apply verbal abuse to the children</li> <li>3. Shame or punish the children when accidents occur</li> <li>4. Deny food or rest as punishment</li> <li>5. Relate discipline to eating, resting, or sleeping</li> <li>6. Leave the children alone, unattended, or without supervision</li> <li>7. Place children in locked rooms etc.</li> <li>8. Allow other children to discipline a child</li> <li>9. Criticize, make fun, or belittle children's family or ethnic group</li> </ol>
